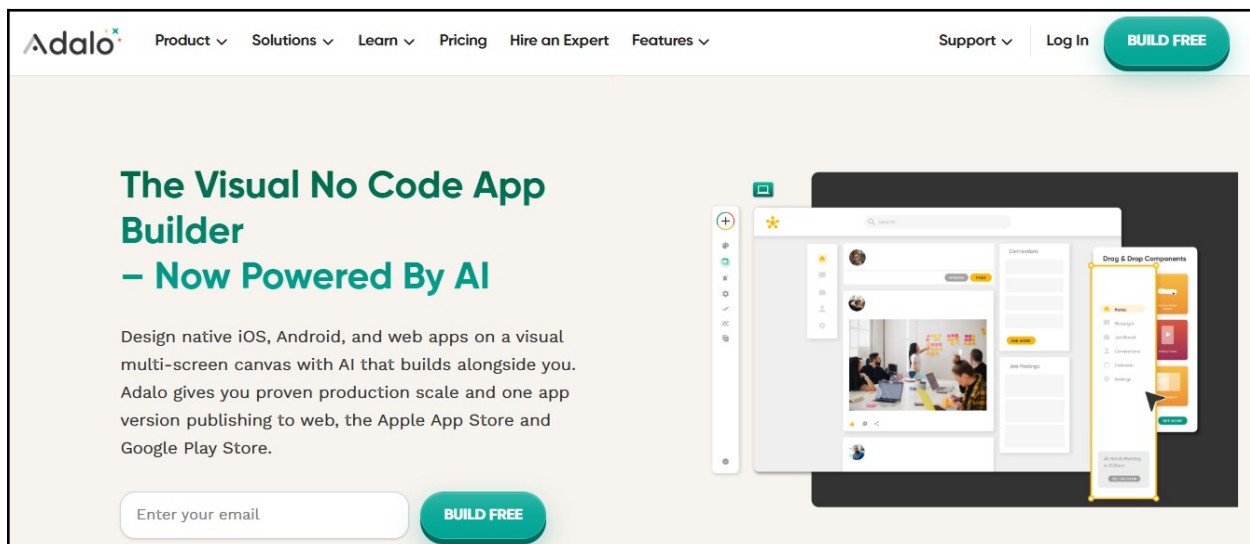
### Where Glide Falls Short

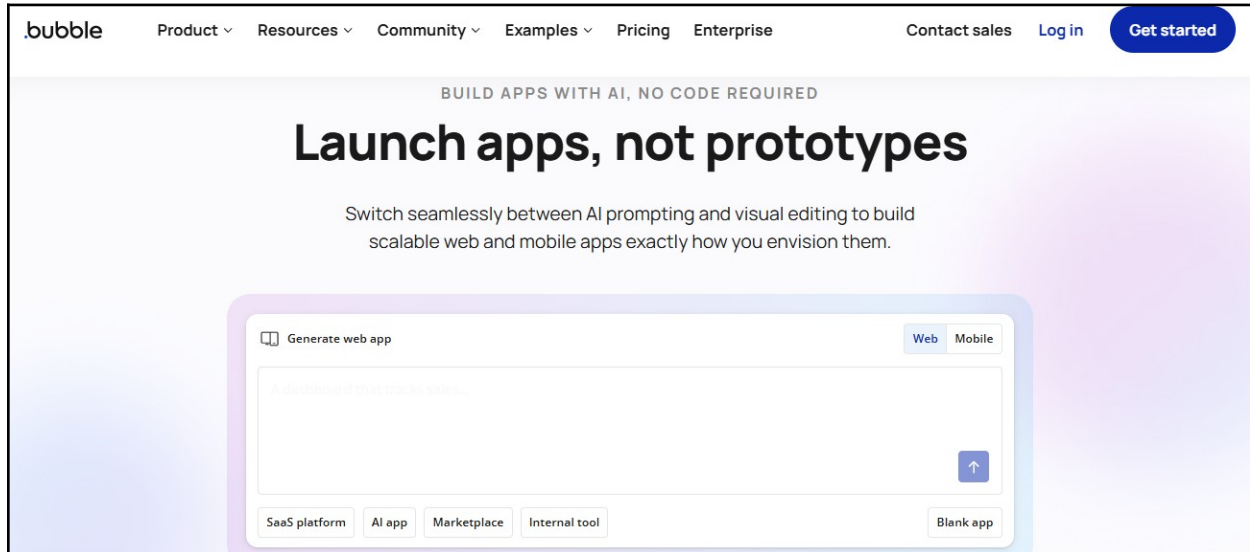
#### Limitation

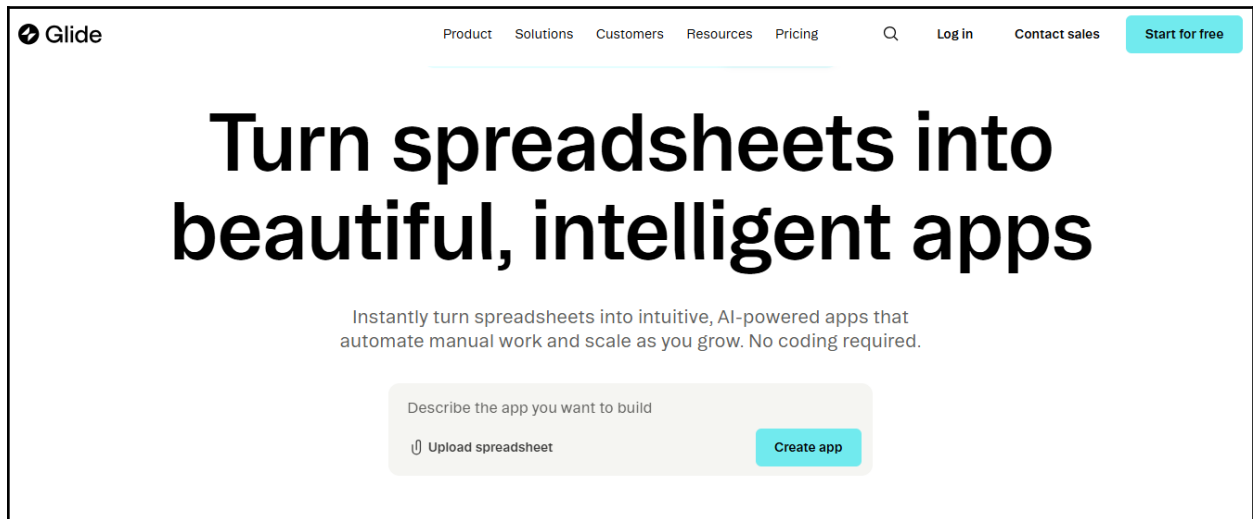
